The BDBT is put together every year by the Eppstein Uhen Foundation of Eppstein Uhen Architects. The **Beyond Design Bike Tour** takes place on **Thursday, September 20, 2018**. It begins in Sullivan, WI at the Concord House. Riders can choose routes from 20, 37, 70 or 103 scenic Wisconsin miles. A light breakfast is provided and a “muscle rebuilding” buffet and silent auction conclude the event.

In 3 years, we have opened 3 food pantries at East High School, Mendota Elementary and Sandburg Elementary, with a fourth opening this fall at Cherokee Heights Middle School.
